Spend your summer preparing for your future. Gain hands on experience under the mentorship of reputable scientists inside the technically advanced labs of the Human BioMolecular Research Institute (HBRI). This is a tremendous opportunity for students to extend their science education. HBRI is a non-profit organization that is focused on the development of fundamental information useful to understand human diseases of the central nervous system, heart and cancer. Included in the areas of study are: regenerative medicine, Alzheimer's disease and related neurodegenerative disorders, Parkinson's disease, depression, drug abuse, chronic pain, cancer and smoking cessation.

HBRI offers summer internships in Biology (Molecular and Cell Biology), Chemistry and Analytical Chemistry open to highly motivated high school juniors and seniors and college students interested in developing scientific expertise.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Open to High school Juniors and Seniors ONLY as well as college Undergraduates.
- Students must reside in San Diego County at the time of the internship.
- Enrolled in advanced or AP Chemistry or Biology courses.
- Students must be able to provide their own transportation.
- Able to work a minimum of 8-10 consecutive weeks, full time during the summer.

(This is to be completed individually by the student and not by a parent.)

3. Have your 3 listed references, with full contact information, (a minimum of one science teacher reference) submit their letters of recommendation via email or US mail to the contact below.
