

Job Description POSTDOCTORAL SCIENTIST

Department: Research

Qualifications: Ph.D., M.D. or equivalent from an accredited institution, additional requirements as specified by the Senior or Staff Scientist.

Function: Receive training that enhances the individual's professional development and future formation of his/her own career. Help design and conduct a research project within the area of active research of the Principal Investigator

Reporting Relationship

Reports To: Senior or Staff Scientist

Supervises: May Supervise research technicians and/or students working on the same project.

Responsibilities:

1. Conduct active lab research on a semi-independent basis: Design and evaluate experiments; develop new ideas that promote current research; prepare and publish scientific manuscripts under direction of Scientist; apply for postdoctoral fellowships under direction of Scientist; attend and give seminars; bring new expertise to the research program.
2. Other responsibilities: Teach techniques to others; train and oversee technicians as determined by a Scientist; may be responsible for operation of specific equipment; serve on internal Institute committees; help further goals of Institute.
3. Perform other duties as assigned by the supervising scientist.
